Greetings from the Last Frontier,

Higher Ground Baptist Bible Camp is owned and operated by the Alaska Baptist Association – a fellowship of thirteen different Baptist churches across the state of Alaska. Many of these churches are mission churches started by Baptist Mid Missions missionaries.

HGBBC is located on the beautiful Kenai Peninsula, about three hours south of Anchorage. The camp is not remote – at least not in the Alaskan sense of the word. The small town of Soldotna is only about 12 miles to the west. We have 154 beautiful acres with facilities capable of housing and feeding about 90 people.

The HGBBC summer is six weeks long, averaging 30 to 40 campers per week. There will be one week of intensive staff training to prepare for the summer. During this week staff will learn how to effectively minister and serve at camp. After staff training, we will have a week of Stretcher training (our high school aged staff) and then youth camps begin with Senior High followed by Junior High, Junior, and Primary weeks. Primary week ends Thursday morning and we are planning on having a Family Camp that weekend to end our summer. For more information concerning dates visit www.hgbbc.com.

Our goal is to see every person who sets foot on camp, including staff, take the next step in his or her spiritual life. Staff will be given an abundance of opportunities to minister in cabins as counselors, as well as to each other. These opportunities will come up as campers are challenged by the Word of God during chapel sessions. During weeks with fewer campers, staff will be used wherever there is a need. Everyone will be given the opportunity to serve in areas such as kitchen and cleaning.

Since we are a small camp, staff will need to raise money for plane tickets and is considered to be volunteer. We encourage staff to contact their home churches, family and friends and let them know of the desire to serve God here at HGBBC! God will provide if it is His will! We will arrange pick up in Anchorage and will take care of staff while here. If there is anything we can do to help please let us know!
